



Donating and Bequests

While not attracting tax relief directly, bequests to registered charities such as the Hampton & Kempton Waterworks Railway are exempt from Estate Duty and may under certain circumstances, reduce the inheritance tax payable on an estate.

Inheritance tax planning is a complex subject and if the circumstances are at all complicated professional advice should be taken.

Bequests are of three main types:

- a fixed amount of money
- a proportion of the Estate
- some, or all of the deceased possessions

In all cases, the full name Hampton & Kempton Waterworks Railway and its registered charity number 1166913 should be included in bequests. It is important that the bequests do not specify any particular project. It could be many years before the bequest is received and if the project were completed by then, the bequest might be considered invalid. If your Will is at all complicated, it is recommended that it is drawn up professionally.
